MYP Fundamental Concepts

This Spanish 2 course will emphasize four main areas of language learning: Reading, writing, speaking and listening. I will use as much Spanish as possible in the classroom to help students acquire the language. Learning Spanish is an on-going process that builds on previously-learned material. Students should be exposed to as much Spanish as possible. It is important that all students practice speaking the language to learn it. It will be beneficial later and build confidence in the student.
